- Learns and writes spellings weekly and is working at age related grade.


Maths

Fatimah enjoys Maths and has made good progress. She is able to: -


- Add & subtract integers including decimals.

- Find the HCF and LCM



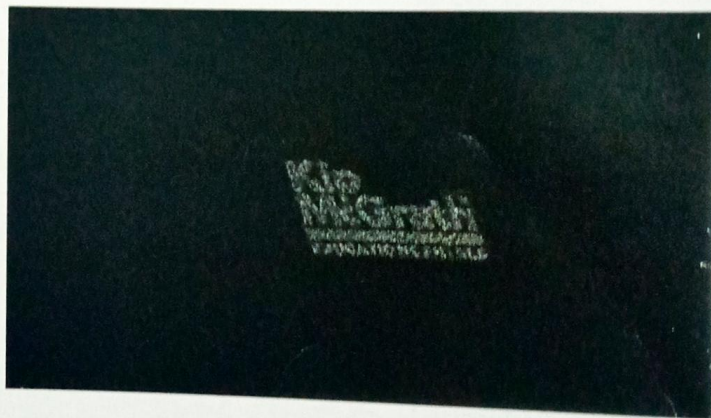


