Liyana has worked hard to achieve the Phonics Screening Check. She is nearly working at the expected standard, but is not yet confidently and fluently reading books matching her phonics ability. Keep persevering!	Liyana is able to write sentences and is starting to link her ideas together. Liyana has worked hard this year to improve her letter formation. Liyana needs to make sure she is using her phonics and common exception word knowledge to spell words correctly or phonetically plausible, being particularly mindful of this when in the flow of writing.	Liyana has made steady progress in maths. She is becoming more confident with using the numbers 1-20 and finding 1 more, 1 less, doubling and halving and simple addition and subtraction. We need to keep working on these foundations as we progress and transfer this knowledge to numbers within 100. Using resources will help to build up her fluency and confidence.
