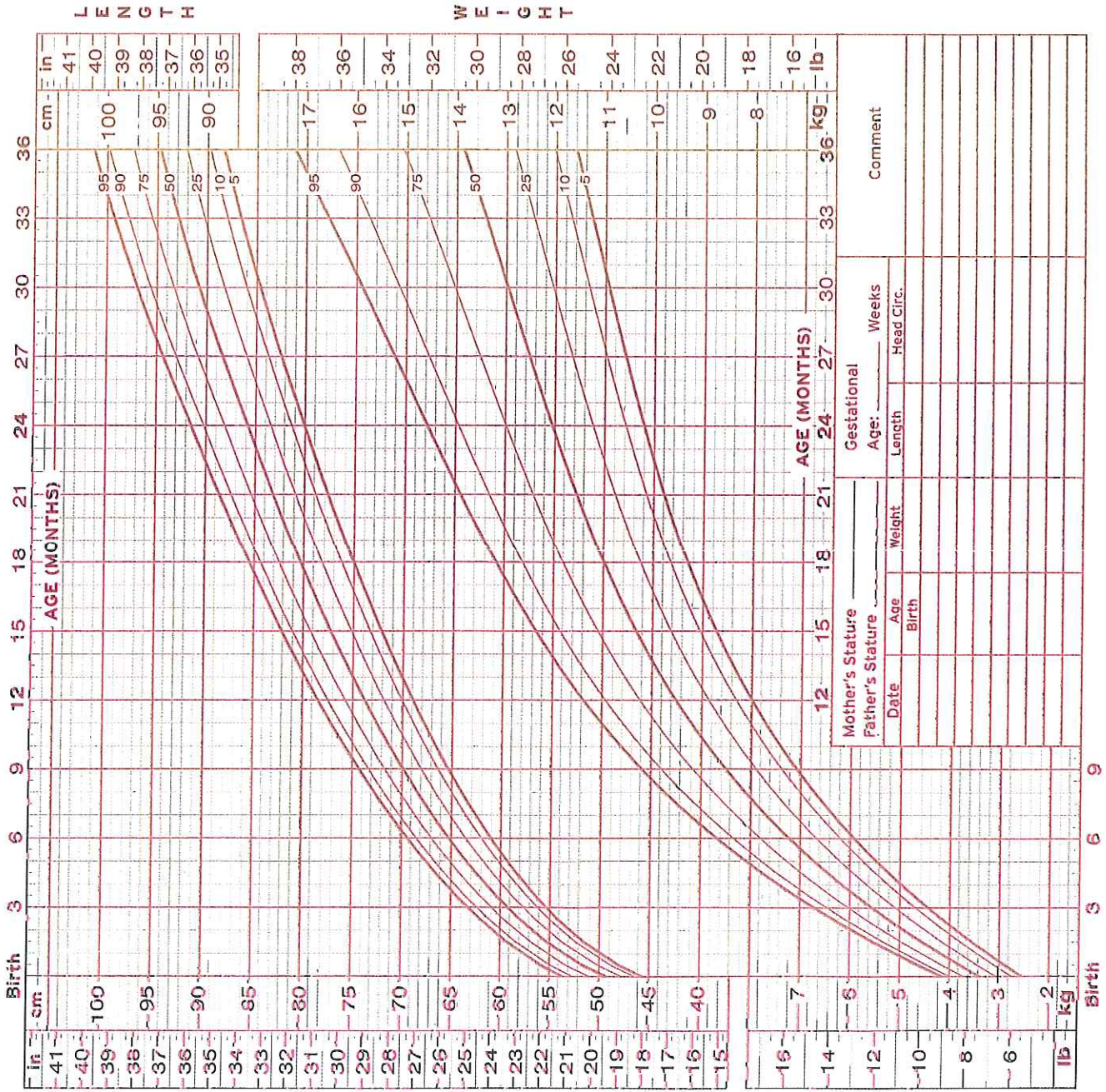


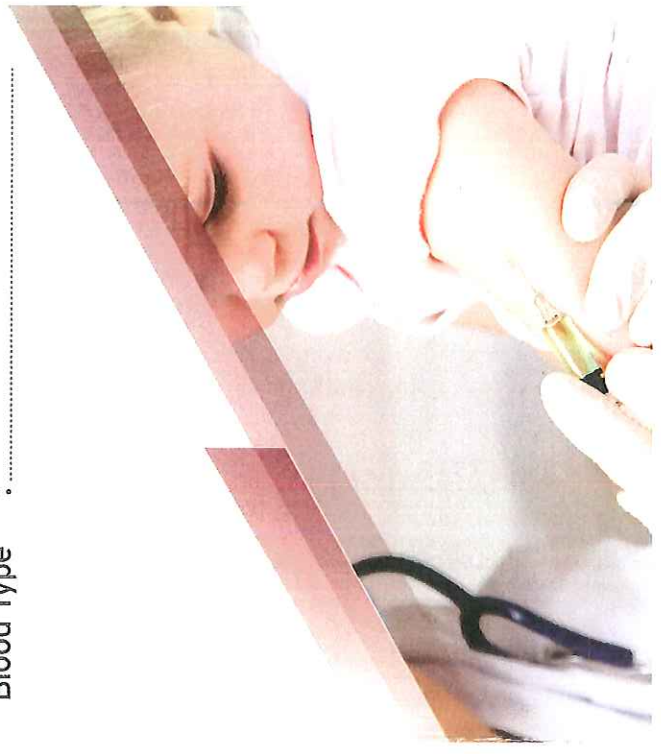

# Your Child's Immunization Schedule

- A. Penta: DTP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) + Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type B) + HBV (Hepatitis B)
- B. Hexa: DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis) + Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type B) + HBV (Hepatitis B) + IPV (Inactivated Polio)
- C. Tetra: (DTaP+Hib) (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis) + Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type B)
- D. DTaP: (Booster) (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis)
- E. Tdap: (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis)

Vaccines recommended for routine administration to children

Highly recommended for all from 6 months yearly

Meningococcal meningitis for Hajj, Umrah & Endemic countries and for children after 2 years.

Following immunization inform the doctor/nurse if your Child is suffering from:

- Epileptic fits, seizures or convulsions
- Any untoward reaction from the previous vaccinations
- Severe cough/colds with fever and not feeling well in anyway

Common Immunization Reactions:

Fever, local swelling, redness and pain at the injection site

Home Care Advice for Immunization Reactions

Local Reaction at injection Site:

Cold Pack : 20 minutes each hour as needed

Fever: Give Acetaminophen or Ibuprofen as needed.

Localized Hives: Apply 1 % hydrocortisone cream OTC once or twice.
