
Form Tutor comment:




Form Tutor comment:

<p>Avicenna is able to access complex texts and his comprehension skills have developed very well. Overall, he has been reluctant to share his responses to a text in whole class live lessons but he has interacted well with his peers when placed in breakout rooms for group work. He is very able in deciphering language structures to support his understanding. His good repertoire of vocabulary and knowledge of literary devices has enabled him to pinpoint and respond accurately in written form with regard to author's intent and he interprets meaning that is inferred. He has shown an increasing awareness of author style and highlighted, although briefly, his preferences in reading materials. He is improving in his ability to extract information in note form and shown in his research presentations that he can turn ideas into his own wording.</p>

<p>Avicenna's writing has improved over the year and he has made good progress in this area. He is quite a slow writer and, on some occasions, his pieces have been too brief. However, he is very capable and it has been a pleasure to read some of his assignments, which have been both entertaining and crafted maturely. When planning for content, he considers his ideas carefully and during the writing process applies the targeted grammatical structures and language features taught. He has successfully analysed models of the text types studied and carefully made use of this understanding to write with clear purpose. He has used stylistic features to create effect in his writing including that of emotive language, which he used very effectively in his persuasive writing to make his arguments relevant and convincing. Avicenna's grammatical correctness is of a good standard as is his ability to use a wide range of sentence types in his work.</p>

<p>Avicenna has made very good progress in mathematics this year. He appears to enjoy this subject and works exceptionally well both independently and when asked to discuss and listen to various methods with his peers. He has absorbed all new concepts with ease and achieved mastery in a range of areas of the subject through successful completion of problem solving questions. His skills in reasoning and critical thinking enable him to determine efficient approaches and methods. He has been particularly successful in algebra and used various formulae to calculate unknown values. He is very confident in fraction calculations and has a sound understanding of the decimal system. His ability to calculate mentally with speed and accuracy is of a good standard. It is expected that he will continue to work at a more advanced level in secondary school and to be highly successful in this area of the curriculum.</p>

He has used correct scientific vocabulary and shown the ability to articulate scientific concepts extremely well. He has been prepared to carry out practical work to support online learning and has recorded his experiments in the correct way. He is able to draw conclusions from his results and identified further lines of enquiry. He is independent in presenting his data and has used line graphs to display results. 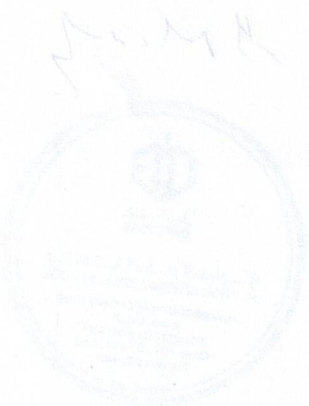


