"Common adverse effect"
● Pain ● Redness ● Swelling at Injection site
● Fever

"Treatment"
● Give paracetamol every 6 to 8 hours as needed
● Put warm compress on injection site
● If worried about child call doctor

Before the immunization tell your doctor if your child:

- Has ever had fits or convulsions
- Had a bad reaction to the last dose
- Is unwell in anyway
