- Area of Development

Reports are produced for each term and will be sent home via the portal, the cycle below shows when you will receive each report.



The purpose of the report is to share the progress of each student according to how their current levels compare to their target. These targets are the minimum each student should aim for. This acts as a baseline and we encourage students to achieve and exceed these targets. This removes a ceiling from what each student could achieve.
