

INTRODUCTION

Students' evaluation is a vital part of any educational process to assess their performance and to provide the information needed to continuously enhance each student's learning.

Student Ability Profile (SAP) provides students and parents with information about the student's progress in all learning areas over a period of time. It includes teachers' assessments of the student's work habits, efforts and behaviours. It also includes student's attendance summary. Moreover, it gives students a chance to identify their improvement needs and make changes to bring their grades up in future.

MECHANISM OF STUDENT'S ASSESSMENT

- 1. The class teachers are provided with Student's Work Plan (SWP) with the aim to assess students' learning in a particular learning area in a systematic way.
- 2. By the end of each term, the class teachers compile the results of students against each learning area in Student's Comprehensive Record (SCR) which remains with them as a record.
- 3. After compiling the data in Student's Comprehensive Record (SCR), the class teachers insert the students' results in Student Ability Profile (SAP) which is shared with the parents during PTMs or when needed.





INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Dear Parents,

When it comes to child's education, parent satisfaction is our utmost priority. We believe that a close and strong communication between parents and teachers is essential to foster the best interest of your child. **Student Ability Profile** indicates your child's development and simultaneously helps him/her to determine his/her goals for learning. Furthermore, it facilitates the teachers to identify the strengths and weaknesses of each child and thereby plan according to individual needs as indicated in the Single National Curriculum.

Important Guidelines:

- 1) It is mandatory for the parents to attend all Parent-Teacher Meetings, so they have an opportunity to discuss their child's progress with teachers.
- 2) Make sure that the child shows punctuality to achieve the high standards of academic progress
- 3) Students in Preschool are assessed, evaluated and promoted through Continuous Assessment as suggested in the Single National Curriculum.
- Always intimate the school administration when your child is absent from the school for any reason.
- 5) Parents are required to pay the fee before collecting **Student Ability Profile**. Fee defaulters will not be allowed to collect the result.
