- Severe cough / colds with fever and not feeling well in

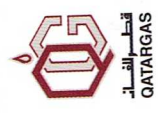
**Common Adverse Effects:**

Give analgesics/antipyretics (Adol) every 6 to 8 hourly as needed. If symptoms persist please see the doctor.
